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International Conference on the Centrality of Jesus Christ

As inspiration, the organizers point to the popes of the new millennium. The "centrality of Jesus Christ" is a recurring theme in the popes' messages.

St. John Paul II asked the Catholic Church to "start afresh from Christ." The program for all ages "has at its center Christ himself, who is to be known, loved and imitated," he said. Pope Benedict XVI wrote three books about *Jesus of Nazareth* and taught that "everything depends on intimate friendship with Jesus."

The first words of Pope Francis after his election were: "All together, pastors and faithful, we will make an effort to respond faithfully to the eternal mission: to lead humanity to

an encounter with Jesus Christ.” During this pandemic, he stressed: “Embracing the Lord frees us from fear and gives us hope.”

The Conference features more than 70 speakers. Among them are: Jason Evert, Deacon Harold Burke-Sivers and Sonja Corbitt from the United States; Jack Valero and Georgia Clarke from the UK; Theresa Okafor from Nigeria; Fr. Jacques Philippe from France; and Andrew Mullins and Madeleine Carrington from Australia.

The Prelate of Opus Dei, Msgr. Fernando Ocariz, will address the participants on the last day of the Conference, December 8. He himself has been seconding the popes' priority thrust. "Putting Jesus Christ at the center of our life" is what he set as priority for the faithful of the prelature.

The Catholic Bishops Conference of the Philippines' *Episcopal Commission for Catechesis and Catholic Education* called on the faithful to participate in this international conference: "Join this rare opportunity provided by Divine Providence, as a way of thanking the Lord for the 500th anniversary of Christianity" in the country.

Parents for Education Foundation (PAREF), the conference organizer, is a community of 14 schools in the Philippines. PAREF has published a book on whose title the conference title is based: *Jesus-Centered: Guide to the Happiest Life*, a handbook of Christian prayer and life.
